



Dog Puppet Made with Paper Lunch Bag

1. Photocopy and cut out individual dog faces.
2. Have children colour their dog face and glue it onto a paper lunch bag to make a puppet – like example to right. Make sure the “chin” of the dog is not glued to the bag.
3. If some children finish their colouring and gluing early, they can draw and colour a body on the bag.
4. Have the children use their puppets to practice the proper way to meet a dog (in partners, taking turns playing the role of “dog guardian”). Remind them that all their dogs are “nice, gentle dogs” so they don’t play aggressively with their puppets.
 - a. Ask the guardian for permission to pet their dog.
 - b. Let dog smell your hand.
 - c. Pet the dog under the chin.
