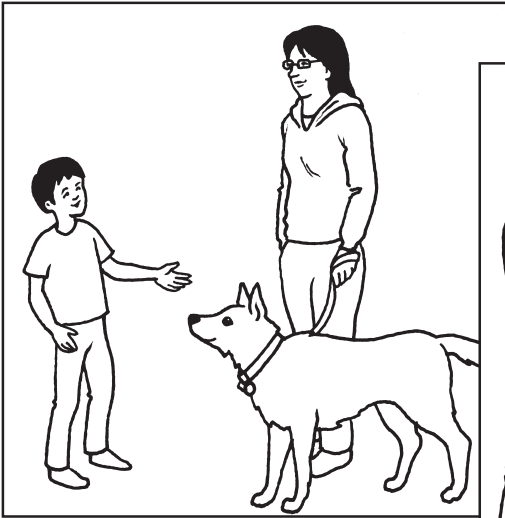
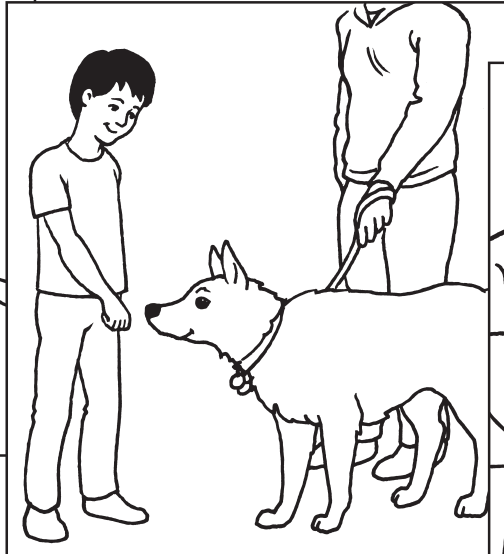


ABCs of Meeting a Dog
